Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing to inform you about a Year 6 trip to the Norfolk Broads on Monday 16th May. This trip is designed to support our current I.C.C. work on Rivers and will allow us to explore the origins of the Broads and compare these to other river systems in the U.K., look for evidence of erosion and deposition, complete investigative fieldwork and explore the nature found within this ecosystem.

The coach will be leaving at **8:15am** promptly so all children need to arrive at school by **8:00am** via the Milford Road entrance **in school uniform**. This is to allow time to register pupils and board the coach. We will be leaving Wroxham at **2:30pm** so should arrive back by the end of the school day.

All children will need to bring a packed lunch from home, plus additional snacks. Please don't forget to include plenty of drinks, but kindly ensure that none of these are carbonated. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the school can provide a lunch if you wish, but the office will need to be told in advance. In addition, please be prepared for the weather and ensure your child has a waterproof jacket and warm clothing should it be cold and wet, but also a sun hat and sunscreen if the forecast is good. The whole day will be spent outdoors.

As the journey is quite short, pupils do not need to bring any entertainment for the coach, but can bring a book to read should they wish.

Any medication needs to be brought into the school office by the morning of **Friday 13th May** at the latest and an accompanying form must be completed by parents. This includes the dispensation of travel sickness tablets. If your child needs an inhaler please ensure that they bring one with them. If you have any questions regarding medication please contact the school office.

The cost of this trip will be £10 per child. The Education Reform Act does not allow the school to charge directly for the cost of school trips but does permit the school to ask for voluntary contributions. Sadly, if we do not receive sufficient contributions it may be we are unable to proceed.
