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Dear Parents/Carers,

Accessing homework and spellings online

This term the children in Year 4 will be trialing using their 'nsix' accounts to access their homework from home. This can be used on any device that connects to the internet (laptops, tablets, smartphones etc). We will continue to give children paper copies of the homework; however our ultimate aim is to reduce our reliance on paper, and teach the children about environmental responsibility. We would welcome any feedback you have about using the new system. There will be an opportunity for you to give feedback to us later this term.

Step by step guide on how to access homework and spellings online

1. Visit the Google Classroom website (<https://classroom.google.com/>)

In the box, children need to enter their 'nsix' email address. All children have been given these and have written them into their homework diaries. If you have any trouble finding this please speak to your child's class teacher who has a record of all user names.



2. You will then be redirected to the Norfolk login page. Again children need to enter their 'nsix' login (which is the part of their email address before the @ sign. E.g. If their email address is jbloggs5fr6@nsix.org.uk, the username is jbloggs5fr6. Again, your child has copied their password into their homework diaries. However, class teachers also have a record should you need to ask them.

3. This will take you to the Google Classroom. Click on Year 4 and you will see the tasks that have been posted on the 'stream' (This is a bit like a newsfeed or timeline you would find on facebook or twitter).



Please remember that there is no need to print anything off; for now children will still be coming home with a paper copy of the homework.

Google classroom is completely secure and is only accessible to children and staff that have secure login details. However, links that are posted may take users outside of this secure space. Please know that Avenue Junior cannot be held responsible for the content of external websites, although staff will only add resources that they believe to be appropriate to your child's learning. We also encourage you to monitor your child's screen time, in line with what you consider to be appropriate for them.
