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Dear Parents or Carers,

For the 2017/18 academic year, we wish to use a website called Class Dojo. Class Dojo is a free website and app designed specifically for infant and primary schools. Class Dojo is a tool for communicating with parents, updating them about events and for sharing important information. It is our hope that this website/app will make communication between home and school easier and more simple, as well as involving parents a little our school day and their child's education.

Children have been sent home with a unique website link that will allow you to join our Class Dojo. You will be asked to sign up using an email address and to create a password before you select your child from the class list. You may also be asked to follow a link as part of the verification process. Once you have signed up, I will be notified of this and will then be able to accept you as part of the group. This process shouldn't take any more than a couple of minutes.

Once you have signed up, you will be able to access a Class Dojo page and class story. The class story is where you will find information, news and updates about the class. On the class story, parents and carers can respond, should they wish to. In addition to this, your child will also have their own 'story' page. As part of this individual story, you may find images of what your child has been doing in class, comments about their day and a record of their team points. Remember to talk to your child about these! Furthermore, these individual story pages allow a secure and private means of communication between the teacher and parent/carer.

The Class Dojo app is available to download on both IOS and Android and is wonderfully easy to navigate and access. If any notifications, messages or updates are sent, these will appear on your phone/tablet screens much like a text message or facebook/twitter notification.

We really hope that many of you take up the opportunity and join your child's Class Dojo. We really do think that it is a hugely valuable and worthwhile tool. We have been using Class Dojo in class over the last few days and the children are all very enthusiastic and excited that parents/carers will see and hear about their successes and achievements each day. We would welcome any feedback about the website/app. If you have any difficulties in signing up, then please do come and speak to your child's class teacher.
