



Sports Premium Strategy 2020-21 (COVID)

Budget: Carry over last year: £2396

Budget this year: £20,700

Total budget: £23,096

Aims

Short term (COVID secure period): (£8,500 & £3456 = £11956)

To provide the resources & training needed to ensure children are active and engaged in safe, COVID compliant and exciting activities

- Equipment purchased
- Release of key staff to support other staff to provide activities

To provide outdoor activities to boost good mental health of pupils e.g. forest schools, COVID secure clubs

Provide online fitness sessions for children who are isolating or home learning (2 hours a week after school time – staffing costs = £873.24)

To provide activities to promote health and fitness in bubbles in addition to PE allocation

Budget: 2 X HLTAs 2 hours per week

1 x CA 2 hours per week

Total staffing costs: £2583 & £873.24

Long term

To provide sustainability in high quality PE for all pupils

- Whole school training of high quality PE delivery
- Release of PE lead to work alongside other deliverers of PE to ensure high quality and provide direction where needed

Purchase of Jasmine PE scheme & training : £1395 + 3 x £495 for training for key staff (& release time to attend courses =£1000) Total: £3880

Release for PE Coordinator to support staff in school: 5 days = £1000

Total amount currently allocated: £16,836

Total still to allocate: £6,260
