This half-term we will be continuing our 'Invaders and Settlers' topic. We will be moving our focus onto the Anglo-Saxon and Viking impact on Britain. We will look at Anglo-Saxon life, jewellery and writing before moving onto learning about the Vikings. We will design and sew our own bag inspired by Anglo-Saxon pouches. We will continue the theme across our curriculum by using the story of Beowulf to support our English learning. We will also create our own Norse myths.
